AOP CAHORS – Château Rouffiac

"Latitude 44"

(red)

Since 2001, the family estate is run by the two brothers Olivier and Pascal Pieron. They have been very involved in the qualitative development and the global revival of the Cahors appellation.

Conscious of the wealth of their land, they manage to develop exceptional wines with a remarkable regularity. The 40 hectares of vines in Rouffiac are situated on one of the best terroir of the appellation, perfect to let the Malbec express itself.

Grape varieties: 100% Malbec

Alc. by Vol.: 12,5% Vol.

Harvest and vinification:

Maceration at low temperature.

Micro-oxygenation in stainless steels vats.

Aged in French oak barrels for 10 months.

Tasting notes:

A dark garnet color with purple hues, typical of Malbec.

A bouquet of red and black fruit, very well combined with hints of vanilla.

Velvety smooth tannins, a silky and seductive mid-palate, and a gentle and aromatic finish.

Very tasty and typically Cahors Malbec!
